The skein of thread used in part 4 is colour No.3 of your chosen colourway which can be found on the thread table. Two strands are used in all of the stitching.





Start by backstitching the outline of the bottom part and spaced back stitch the line through the centre. The top part is satin stitch. It is easiest to begin the satin stitch at the fat end and work towards the thin end. To help with the angle you make the satin stitch, imagine or draw it on if more helpful, that there is a line that runs from the point to the centre of the bottom. Your satin stitches should run at a 90 degree angle to this





These leaves are really simple. Just a stem stitch for the stem, outline and spine of the leaves, then a backstitch for the veins. Page 1 of 1
